Our definition of God's glory falls far short of everything that it is. We can only but glimpse at, and attempt to put into simple words the honor, splendor, and greatness of the amazing, dazzling, radiant glory of our Lord.

*Romans 1:20 "For the **invisible things** of him from the creation of the world are **clearly seen**, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse"*

### III. Convictions in a \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 12-14)

A Conviction involves some need. There are physical needs that most of us are aware of, such as clothing, shelter, and food. But conviction involves spiritual needs. There are two ways this word 'conviction' is used.

1. **Conviction** = being convinced of your own guilt. God convicts us of our sin by presenting compelling evidence that you have broken His law.

2. **A Conviction** = A standard which you hold in your life that is formed by some authority. This authority can be God, or public opinion, or a group that you adhere to. Whichever authority you serve will establish this standard as a rule or model by which you live your life.
