#### I. FIRST, WE FIND HIS \_\_\_\_\_ PASSION (Romans 10:1a) *“Brethren, my heart’s desire . . .”*

Two things that are missing from Paul’s “suitcase.”

A. First, there was no deep \_\_\_\_\_ present in Paul’s “suitcase.”

B. Secondly, there was no desire for \_\_\_\_\_ present in Paul’s “suitcase.”

#### II. SECONDLY, WE FIND HIS \_\_\_\_\_ PLEADING (Romans 10:1b) *“Brethren, my heart’s desire and prayer for Israel . . .”*

Why pray for the unsaved who have rejected the Lord Jesus?

A. First, because he is the only God worth praying to because He is the only one who is \_\_\_\_\_.
