- II. **SECONDLY, NOTICE THE _____ OR IMPARTIALLY OF THE GOSPEL (Romans 10:12a) “For there is no difference between the Jew and Greek . . .”**

- III. **THIRDLY, THERE IS THE _____ OR INHERITANCE OF THE GOSPEL (Romans 10:12b). “. . . for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him.”**

Some examples of “rich” or “riches”:

- Ephesians 1:7-8a. *To whom we have redemption though his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace. Wherein he had abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence: Having made known unto us the mystery of his will . . .”*
- Ephesians 2:4-7. *“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us. Even when we were dead in trespasses and sins, hath quicken us together with Christ (by grace ye are saved:) And hath raised us up together and made us to sit in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches toward us through Christ Jesus.”*
