

## SEEKING A LIFE WITH A HEART FOR GOD—1

### *“The Making of a Champion”*

1 Samuel 16:1-13

Introduction. One could outline David’s biography as follows:

- I. Section #1—David’s \_\_\_\_\_ [1 Samuel 16-31].
- II. Section #2—David’s \_\_\_\_\_ [2 Samuel 1-10].
- III. Section #3—David’s \_\_\_\_\_ [2 Samuel 11-20]

What is God going to do to manufacture a disciple out of David? In reviewing these verses, let’s notice the teachings in this passage as we think about God making choices:

#### **I. FIRST, WE MUST UNDERSTAND THAT GOD’S CHOICES ARE \_\_\_\_\_ [1 Samuel 16:1].**

- A. First, His choices involved an unlimited \_\_\_\_\_ [16:1a].
- B. Secondly, His choices included unlimited \_\_\_\_\_ [16:1b].
- C. Thirdly, His choices incorporate unlimited \_\_\_\_\_ [16:1c].

#### **II. SECONDLY, WE MUST CONCLUDE THAT GOD’S CHOICES ARE SOMETIMES \_\_\_\_\_ [1 Samuel 16:6-13].**

- A. First, God’s choices are unexpected in their \_\_\_\_\_ [13:6-10].
- B. Secondly, God’s choices are unexpected because of their \_\_\_\_\_ [13:7].
- C. Thirdly, God’s choices are unexpected because of their \_\_\_\_\_ [13:11-13].

#### **III. THIRDLY, WE MUST ACCEPT THE FACT THAT GOD’S CHOICES ARE VERY \_\_\_\_\_ [1 Samuel 16:11-13].**

- A. First, God uniquely chooses those who are \_\_\_\_\_ [13:5, 11-12].
- B. Secondly, God uniquely chooses those who are \_\_\_\_\_ [13:11].
- C. Thirdly, God uniquely chooses those who are \_\_\_\_\_ [13:13].

#### **CONCLUSION: Notice the following application:**
