

“T’WAS THE SUNDAY AFTER THANKSGIVING”

Hebrews 13:5-15

Introduction. _____

In this passage there are some UNCHANGING blessings that go past Thanksgiving Day:

I. FIRST, THERE IS AN UNCHANGING BLESSING IN OUR _____ (Hebrews 13:5-6, 8).

A. First, notice His _____ presence [Hebrews 13:5c]. “... *for he hath said, I will never leave thee nor forsake thee.*”

B. Secondly, consider His _____ presence [Hebrews 13:6]. “*So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.*”

C. Thirdly, note His _____ presence [Hebrews 13:8]. “*Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever.*”

II. SECONDLY, THERE IS AN UNINTERRUPTED BLESSING IN OUR _____ (Hebrews 13:9-12).

A. First, note that our salvation involved a _____ [13:9]. “... *grace* ...”

B. Secondly, notice that our salvation included _____ [13:12b]. “... *that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.*”

C. Thirdly, consider how our salvation incorporated a _____ [13:12a] “*Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people . . .*”

III. THIRDLY, THERE IS AN UNCEASING BLESSING IN OUR _____ (Hebrews 13:13).

IV. FOURTHLY, THERE IS AN UNRIVALED BLESSING OF OUR _____ (Hebrews 13:14).
