

# A SUBJECT ON THE ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST

When people deny the doctrine of Hell, they do it from at least three basic approaches:

1. \_\_\_\_\_—There is NO GOD, therefore there is NO HELL.
2. \_\_\_\_\_—There is a God, but it is silly to speculate about millions of disembodied souls and spirits frying in a lake of fire somewhere.
3. \_\_\_\_\_—There is a God, but He is a God of love and therefore He would not and could not send anyone to Hell.

Today, let's look at this account in Luke about a man in hell and discover four truths about this doctrine:
