EYE WITNESSES OF THE END TIMES—12a Jesus as a LION in the Midst of JUDGMENT "When The LION Takes A Timeout"

Revelation 7:1-17; 14:1-5

Introduction		

I. FIRST, NOTE THE <u>SUSPENSION</u> OF JUDGMENT (Revelation 7:1-3).

- A. First, notice the *instruments* used in this suspension (7:1).
- B. Secondly, note the <u>intention</u> of this suspension (7:1-3).

II. SECONDLY, CONSIDER THE <u>SEALING</u> OF THE JEWS (Revelation 7:4-8).

- A. First, notice how they are <u>named</u> (7:4c). "... of the tribes of the children of Israel."
- B. Secondly, note how they are *numbered* (7:5-8).
- C. Thirdly, consider how they are <u>needed</u> (7:9; 14:1-5).
 - 1. First, note some *observations* from the text in Revelation 14:1-5).

- a. First, they are sealed as the Sovereign Lord's *possession* (14:1).
- b. Secondly, they are sealed with supernatural *protection*.
- c. Thirdly, they are sealed with supernatural *power*.
- d. Fourthly, they are sealed with a symbolic *pledge* (14:9d).
- 2. Secondly, some *characteristics* of these from the text (14:4-5).
 - a. First, they are marked by their *purity* (14:4a).
 - b. Secondly, they are marked by their <u>loyalty</u> (14:4b).
 - c. Thirdly, they are marked by their *honesty* (14:5).
 - d. Fourthly, they are marked by their <u>destiny</u> (14:5b).
