

## EYE WITNESSES OF THE END TIMES—13b

#### Jesus as LOVER in the midst of a MARRIAGE

#### “The BRIDEGROOM Prepares a Place for the BRIDE

Revelation 20:1-10

#### I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW SATAN IS REMOVED (Revelation 20:1-3).

- A. First, notice the period when Satan is removed and bound (20:1-2).
- B. Secondly, notice the place where Satan is removed and bound (20:3).
- C. Thirdly, consider the purpose for which Satan is removed and bound (20:3d).

#### II. SECONDLY, CONSIDER HOW CHRIST WILL REIGN (Revelation 20:4-6).

- A. First, notice how His reign is promised (Daniel 2:44).
- B. Secondly, note how His reign is peopled (20:4).
  - 1. First, they are resurrected (20:4d).
  - 2. Secondly, who will reign (20:4-5).
- C. Thirdly, consider His reign as to its purpose.

- 1. First, note God’s promise to Israel (Genesis 12:1-3; 15:4-17).
- 2. Secondly, notice God’s promise to Jesus (Psalm 110).
- 3. Thirdly, consider God’s promise to the Gentiles (Daniel 7:11-4; Isaiah 11:9; Luke 19:12-27; 1 Corinthians 6:2; Revelation 5:10).
- 4. Fourthly, see how He made a promise to His creation (Isaiah 11:6-9; 36:9; 65:25; Romans 8:18-23).

#### D. Fourthly, notice how His reign proceeds.

- 1. First, it will be a rule over the entire earth (Daniel 7:14).
- 2. Secondly, it will be a rule that will be exact in authority and power (Psalm 2:9; 72:9-11; Isaiah 11:4).
- 3. Thirdly, it will be a rule that will be exercised in righteousness and justice (Isaiah 11:3-4; Psalm 2:10-12).

#### E. Fifthly, rejoice that He will reign in pleasure.

- 1. First, this pleasure will include a time of universal knowledge (Isaiah 11:9b).
- 2. Secondly, this pleasure will introduce righteous human conduct (11:3-5; 2:4).
- 3. Thirdly, this pleasure will involve an unusual time of joy and peace (Isaiah 32:15; 44:3; Ezekiel 39:29; Joel 2:28-29).

F. Sixthly, remember that He will reign in *passion* and worship.

1. First, in relation to the *Person* of Jesus Christ.
2. Secondly, relation to a debated *point* (Ezekiel 40:1—46:24).

**III. THIRDLY, NOTE HOW THE NATIONS WILL \_\_\_\_\_ (Revelation 20:7-10).**
