III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER THE _____ FOR REAL FREEDOM.

The cost of real freedom was the death of the Lord Jesus Christ on the cross of Calvary:

* It was there that He *“gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time”* (1 Timothy 2:6).

* It was there that *“he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed”* (Isaiah 53:5).

* It was there that *“the LORD . . . laid upon him the iniquity of us all”* (Isaiah 53:6).
