

**“THE GREATEST COMEBACK OF ALL TIMES”**

Luke 24:13-35

If Luke’s account here were treated as a “comeback,” it would happen in five steps. Note them:

- I. **IN THE FIRST STEP, ONE CAN SEE TWO DISCIPLES WHO’S HEARTS ARE OVERWHELMED WITH \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:13-14).**
  
- II. **IN THE SECOND STEP, ONE CAN SEE JESUS JOINING THE TWO BY OVERSHADOWING THEIR \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:15-24).**
  
- III. **IN THE THIRD STEP, ONE CAN SEE THE MINDS OF THE DISCIPLES BEING OPENED TO THE \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:25-28).**

IV. **IN THE FOURTH STEP, ONE CAN SEE THE DISCIPLES’ EYES OPENED \_\_\_\_\_ THE \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:29-32).**

V. **IN THE FIFTH STEP, ONE CAN SEE THE DISCIPLES’ MOUTHS OPENED \_\_\_\_\_ THE \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:33-35).**

**CONCLUSION:** It is no surprise that Jesus worked in this order:

1. **First, He opened their minds to the \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 10:17). “So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”**
  
2. **Secondly, He opened their eyes to the \_\_\_\_\_ (Isaiah 45:22) “Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.”**
  
3. **Thirdly, they opened their mouths telling about their \_\_\_\_\_! (Romans 10:9) “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.**
