### “How God Justifies The Ungodly”

### “God Saves the Ungodly Forever”

Romans 5:1-21

Introduction: \_\_\_\_\_

#### I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW GOD HAS LIFTED US (Romans 5:1-5).

A. First, notice the reminder of our standing (5:1-2).

1. First, notice there is acceptance (5:1).
2. Secondly, notice there is access (5:2).

B. Secondly, notice there is a recall of our state (5:3-5).

1. First, he shows how victory or maturity is displayed (5:3).
2. Secondly, he shows how victory or maturity is developed (5:4-5a).
3. Thirdly, he shows how victory or maturity is determined for us (5:5b).

#### II. SECONDLY, NOTICE HOW GOD HAS LOVED US (Romans 5:6-11).

A. First, look at the proof of God’s love (5:6-8).

1. First, Paul describes how God’s love as unconditional (5:6).
2. Secondly, Paul demonstrates how God’s love is incomparable (5:7-8).

B. Secondly, consider the provision of God’s love (5:9-10).

1. First, see how Christ gave His life for us (5:9-10a).
2. Secondly, consider how Christ gave His life to us (5:10b).

C. Thirdly, note the product of God’s love (5:11).

#### I. THIRDLY, CONSIDER HOW GOD HAS \_\_\_\_\_ US (5:12-21).

A. First, notice how he \_\_\_\_\_ the problem of sin (5:12-14)

1. First, he declares it by showing its \_\_\_\_\_ (5:12a).
2. Secondly he declares it by showing its \_\_\_\_\_ (5:12b).
3. Thirdly, he declares it by showing its \_\_\_\_\_ (5:13-14).

B. Secondly, note how he \_\_\_\_\_ the problem of sin (5:15-21).

Notice how the Second Man, Jesus restores all Adam lost:

1. First, He did it through His free \_\_\_\_\_ (5:15-17).

- a. First, it releases us from \_\_\_\_\_ (5:15).
- b. Secondly, it clears us from \_\_\_\_\_ (5:16).
- c. Thirdly, it frees us from \_\_\_\_\_, that is the bondage of death (5:17).

3. Secondly, He did it through His \_\_\_\_\_ (5:18-21)

- a. First, Paul reveals to us something of the \_\_\_\_\_ supply of God’s grace (5:18-19).
- b. Secondly, he reminds us of the \_\_\_\_\_ sovereignty of God’s grace (5:20-21).
  - (1) First, His grace \_\_\_\_\_ (5:20).
  - (2) Secondly, His grace \_\_\_\_\_ (5:21)

**CONCLUSION: Two very important lessons:**

1. **There is no way to \_\_\_\_\_ the Fall of Adam except through the blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ.**
2. **There is no way to \_\_\_\_\_ the damage done by Adam’s fall except through God’s grace.**
