III. THIRDLY, HE _____ THE APPLICATION OF DEATH AND REMARRIAGE (Romans 7:5-6).

Here Paul contrasts the OLD LIFE OF SIN and the NEW LIFE IN THE SPIRIT and shows us what changes have taken place as the result of this REMARRIAGE to Christ:

A.	Fir	est, notice the old life of (6:5).	
	1.	First, we were to the flesh (6:5a) "For when we were in the flesh "	
	2.	Secondly, we were by the motions of sin (6:5b) " the motions of sin"	
	3.	Thirdly, we were to sin by the law (6:5c) " which were by the law"	
	4.	Fourthly, we were engaged in working out our own death (6:5d) " did work in our members to bring forth death."	
В.	Secondly, consider now the new life in the(6:6).		
	1.	First, we have been from the law (6:6b-c) " we have been delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held"	
	2.	Secondly, we have been to serve (6:6d) " that we should serve in newness of spirit"	
	3.	Thirdly, we now have a new life with which to better serve Him (6:6d) " and not in the oldness of letter."
