## I. FIRST, NOTICE MAN'S <u>REBELLION</u> AGAINST GOD (Romans 1:18).

- A. First, man's rebellion expresses itself in that it is *unwanted* by the nature of man.
- B. Secondly, man's rebellion exposes itself in that it is *unaccepted* by the religion of man.

## II. SECONDLY, NOTE MAN'S <u>REVELATION</u> OF GOD (ROMANS 1:19-20). THE EVIDENCE: <u>SELF-EVIDENT</u> TRUTH!

- A. First, notice the *place* of God's revelation (1:19a). Evidence that the truth is within man—the truth of *conscience*. We will call this the *inner* light!
- B. Secondly, note the <u>power</u> of God's revelation (1:19b) Evidence of God's seen in nature or <u>creation</u>. We will call this the <u>outer</u> light!
- C. Thirdly, consider the <u>purpose</u> of God's revelation (1:20).
