Three levels of knowledge:

1. There is what is called \_\_\_\_\_ awareness (MIND)
2. There is what is called \_\_\_\_\_ description (EMOTION)
3. There is what is called \_\_\_\_\_ possession (WILL)

**I. FIRST, NOTICE THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF MAN’S REBELLION (Romans 1:24-15).**

- A. First, it is based on sinful \_\_\_\_\_ (1:24).
- B. Secondly, it is based on sinful \_\_\_\_\_ (1:25).

**II. SECONDLY, CONSIDER THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF MAN’S REBELLION (Romans 1:26-27).**

- A. First, notice how man’s attraction becomes \_\_\_\_\_ (1:26-27a).
- B. Secondly, note how man’s addiction becomes \_\_\_\_\_ (1:27b).

**III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF MAN’S SINFUL REBELLION (Romans 1:28-32).**

- A. First, it is defined in his \_\_\_\_\_ (1:28).
- B. Secondly, it is displayed in his \_\_\_\_\_ (1:28b-31).

1. First, their depravity is depicted in their \_\_\_\_\_ (1:28c).
2. Secondly, their depravity is discovered in their \_\_\_\_\_ (1:29-31).
  - a. First, note how the first five sins relate to the \_\_\_\_\_ of others (1:29a).
  - b. Secondly, notice how the 2<sup>nd</sup> five sins relate to the \_\_\_\_\_ of others (1:29b).
  - c. Thirdly, consider how the 3<sup>rd</sup> six sins relate to their \_\_\_\_\_ toward others (1:29b-30c).
  - d. Fourthly, see how the 4<sup>th</sup> fourth group of seven sins represents the \_\_\_\_\_ or feelings of others (1:30b-31).
3. Thirdly, their depravity is described in their \_\_\_\_\_ (1:32).
  - a. First, notice the ultimate \_\_\_\_\_ of depravity.
    - \* When they reject God, it leads to \_\_\_\_\_ of sin (Romans 1:24).
    - \* When sin is accepted, it leads to \_\_\_\_\_ of sin (Romans 1:26).
    - \* When the approval of sin, finally degenerates into the \_\_\_\_\_ of sin (Romans 1:32).
  - b. Secondly, note the ultimate \_\_\_\_\_ from depravity.
    - (1) First, there needs to be an \_\_\_\_\_—“*I am a sinner.*”
    - (2) Secondly, there needs to be a \_\_\_\_\_—“*Lord, please forgive me as a sinner.*”
    - (3) Thirdly, there needs to be \_\_\_\_\_—“*Lord, I repent of my sin, and ask you to save me now.*”
