Romans 2:17-24

Introduction:_____

I. FIRST, NOTICE THE SPIRITUAL <u>CONFIDENCE</u> OF THE RELIGIOUS JEW (Romans 2:17-20).

There are five reasons why faithful Jews felt eternally safe:

- A. First, because of their <u>lineage</u> (2:17a). "Behold, thou art called a <u>Jew</u>..."
- B. Secondly, because they boasted of their <u>Law</u> (2:17b) "... and restest in the law..."
- C. Thirdly, because of their <u>Lord</u> (2:17c) "... and makest thy boast in God."
- D. Fourthly, because of what they had <u>learning</u> (2:18) "And knowest his will, and approves the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law."

Note what their learning contained:

- 1. First, in included their special <u>knowledge</u> (2:18a) "And knowest his will . . . "
- 2. Secondly, it involved their keen *insight* (2:18b) "... and *approvest the things that are excellent*..."
- 3. Thirdly, it incorporated their biblical <u>education</u> (2:18c) *"... being instructed out of the law."*
- E. Fifthly, because of their *leadership* (2:19-20).

CONCLUSION: Note some things possible from this passage:

- 1. It is possible for religious exercises to touch the <u>mind</u> and <u>emotions</u> of a person without reaching the <u>will</u> and the <u>heart</u>.
- 2. It is possible to be moved <u>emotionally</u> by religion without being spiritually <u>awake</u> by the Redeemer.
- 3. It is possible to be <u>religious</u>, but not <u>redeemed</u>.
