WHAT WE BELIEVE AND HOW WE BEHAVE—9 "Just How Does God Save Sinners?"

"The New Man In The Mirror—Redeemed and Righteous"

Romans 3:19-31

Introduction:_____

I. FIRST, THE NEW MAN IN THE MIRROR WAS A <u>RUINED</u> MAN (Romans 3:19-20).

A. First, he is *declared* a sinner by the Law (3:19). He is *helpless*.

Notice what this verse reveals:

- 1. First, man is *convicted* by sin by his understanding of the law (3:19a).
- 2. Secondly, man is *condemned* by God's law by his understanding of the law (3:19b).
- B. Secondly, he is <u>damned</u> and doomed a sinner by the law (3:20). He is <u>hopeless</u>.
- II. SECONDLY, NOTICE NOW, HOW HE IS A <u>REDEEMED</u> MAN (Romans 3:21-26).
- A. First, note how he has experienced *freedom* (3:21-24).
 - 1. First, God's plan of salvation is completely <u>Scriptural</u> (3:21)
 - a. First, because it conforms to the *standards* of the law (3:21a).
 - b. Secondly, because it conforms to the *statements* of the prophets (3:21b).
 - 2. Secondly, God's plan of salvation is carefully *suitable* (3:22-16).
 - 1. First, salvation is suitable because it is unique in its *approach* (3:22).
 - 2. Secondly, salvation is suitable because it is universal in its *appeal* (3:23).
 - a. First, notice a *universal* verdict (3:23a).

- b. Secondly, note an *irrevocable* condition (3:23b).
- c. Thirdly, consider the *irrefutable* offense (3:23c).
- d. Fourthly, take note of an *impassable* chasm (3:23d).
- e. Fifthly, look now at an *unreachable* goal (3:23e).
- B. Secondly, he has experienced _____(3:24-26).
 - 1. First, He understands the _____ condition of man (3:24-26a).
 - a. First, notice that because of man's ruin, salvation is based on a remarkable ______(3:24a).
 - b. Secondly, note that because of man's ruin, salvation is based upon a redemptive _____ (3:24b-25).
 - 2. Secondly, he unleashes the _____ character of God (3:26b).

III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER THEN, HOW HE IS A ______ MAN (Romans 3:27-31).

- A. First, because the believer has a new relationship with the _____ (3:27-28).
- B. Secondly, it is because the believer has a new relationship with the _____(3:29-30).
- C. Thirdly, it is because the believer has a new relationship with _____(3:31).
