I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW A PERSON WITH A
RADICAL WORLD VISION HAS A
CONFIRMATION (Romans 15:18-19a). They will be
Fruitful!

- A. First, he has been confirmed by a heavenly walk (15:18c) “. . . *make the Gentiles obedient by work and deed.*”
- B. Secondly, he has been confirmed by a heavenly work (15:18a). “*For I will not dare speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought in me . . .*”
- C. Thirdly, he has been confirmed by heavenly wonders (15:18-19a).

II. SECONDLY, NOTE HOW A PERSON WITH A
RADICAL WORLD VISION HAS A
COMMITMENT (Romans 15:19b). They will be
Faithful!

- A. First, he will be committed to Christ’s mission (15:19b) “. . . *from Jerusalem to Illyricum . . .*”
- B. Secondly, he will be committed to Christ’s message (15:19b). “. . . *I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.*”

III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER HOW A PERSON WITH
A RADICAL WORLD VISION IS
_____ (Romans 15:20-21). They will be

- A. First, as a radical, he is concentrated on new _____ (15:20a). “*Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel not where Christ was named . . .*” His _____.
- B. Secondly, as a radical, he is concentrated on new _____ (15:20b). “. . . *lest I should build upon another man’s foundation.*” His _____.
- C. Thirdly, as a radical, he is concentrated on new faces (15:21). “*But as it is written, To whom he was not spoke of, they shall see and they have not heard shall understand.*” His _____.
