#### I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW THEY RECEIVED THE WORD \_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 17:10-11).

- A. First, the Bereans were \_\_\_\_\_ to hear God’s Word (17:11b). *“... received the word with readiness of mind...”*

#### III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER HOW THEY ADAPTED THE TRUTH \_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 17:12). *“Therefore many believed, and also honorable women which were Greeks, of men, not a few.”*

**CONCLUSION:** Let’s summarize the message and apply it in two closing principles:
